We will be able to take walk-in registrations but will require everyone to set up an account online using a laptop at the Recreation

BRASS CONNECTION: We are a brass quintet that takes your audience on a musical odyssey. We play a fun, upbeat, family style Pops concert including Patriotic Selections, Big Band Swing, Light Classics, Music from the Movies and Television, Dixieland, Blues, Tijuana Brass, Broadway Show Medleys, as well as music from Chicago and the Beatles. We invite the kids from the audience to play percussion with us on one of the marches.

River's Edge Arts Alliance – Arts in the Park: ARTIST APPRECIATION CONCERT: Concert by the River's Edge is a wonderful summer concert featuring the River's Edge Community Band, Chorale and Youth Chorus. This year's highlights features all three groups performing the 1812 Overture and a salute to the 75th Anniversary of The Wizard of Oz. A presentation to the recipient of the Artist Appreciation Award will also be featured.

JUMPIN' JUBA: JUMPIN' JUBA plays a mix of roots-y rock & roll, blues, folk, jazz and Americana. This trio (guitar/vocal; piano, drums) moves from barrelhouse boogie to memphis rock & roll to straight Chicago blues, with touches of Latin, reggae, calypso, Tex-Mex and jazz stirred into the band's blue stew. River's Edge Arts Alliance –Arts in the Park: SUMMER FUN CELEBRATION CONCERT: Summer Celebration will feature a preview of the Summer Drama Workshop performances of The Wizard of Oz, Young Performers Edition by Theater Too!, Annie Jr. by students of Children's Theater and 42nd Street by students of Youth Theater. The performances of these groups in July will be a culmination of a great year of Hometown themed performances and events. FLASHBACK: We are a 4 piece classic rock'n roll band and the members are in their 50's and 60's that play cover music in the 60's, 70's, and 80's. We have been together for nine years and have a good following. The music is very entertaining for any age group and we play great sing along songs that everyone will know.

THE LENNY SOLOMON BAND: The band, which consists of vocals, two guitars, and upright bass, play originals and assorted covers in a style that's a combination of folk, country, and blues. All of our material is family friendly but geared to an adult audience.

TOM YATES W/ THE WORKINGMAN'S BAND: The Workingman's Band is a classic rock trio of guitar/vocals, bass and drums featuring guitarist/vocalist Tom Yates formerly of Hudson. Our repertoire encompasses the rock and roll songs form the 1950's to the 1980's. We feature music that was performed at the 1969 Woodstock Festival by such artists as Jimi Hendrix, Carlos Santana, Canned Heat, The Who, Creedence Clearwater Revival, Ten Years After, Paul Butterfield Blues Band, Johnny Winter. Our performance aims to excite the audience to dance and sing along with the music in the spirit of the summer of love.
