Participants must be currently in Grades K -1. Children who enroll will participate in a 45-minute clinic each week, for 6 weeks. Exact schedules will be emailed out to participants in late December. Please note: Participants will not be participating in "scrimmages/games" but rather participating in "drills and fun games", focused on learning and building on the fundamentals of basketball.

Registration:

Registration must be completed online or at the Recreation Office by Monday, December 19th. Registrations received after December 19th will be accepted only if space is available (a late fee of \$20.00 per child will be charged per participant). *IF YOUR CHILD IS A NON-RESIDENT, BUT ATTENDS HUDSON PUBLIC SCHOOLS, PLEASE CONTACT HUDSON RECREATION TO REGISTER.

- Saturdays, starting January 7th – February 11th
- Clinic times (45 minutes session each week) will vary over the 6 weeks. Historically sessions take place between 8am and 12pm.
