#### **NEW DIVISIONS FOR 2023-2024**

#### Coed Grade 2 -

For children currently in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. This level builds upon the fundamentals of our Kindergarten / Grade 1 program and introduces players to "game situations" on an 8' basket. Basic basketball skills and strategies will be introduced. Learning and building on the fundamentals are still the top priority of this level. In addition to weekly practices, each Saturday in December will consist of "mini-clinics" followed by a 20-minute game. Starting in January, each Saturday will consist of a full game.

# Boys 3/4 & Girls 3/4

For children currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade. This level builds upon the fundamentals of our Coed Grade 2 program. Players will take part in regulation games on a 9' basketball with a scorekeeper and a certified referee. Learning and building on the fundamentals are still the top priority of this level.

### Boys 5/6 & Girls 5/6

For children currently in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Players will take part in regulation games on a 10' basket with a scorekeeper and certified referees. Stats and scores are used for internal purposes only. No standings or game results are posted.

## Boys 7/8 & Girls 7/8

For children currently in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Players will take part in regulation games on a 10' basket with a scorekeeper and certified referees. Standings will be posted for playoff purposes, but individual stats and game results will not be posted. The season will conclude with playoffs.

## Registration:

Register online or in-person at the Hudson Recreation Office, Town Hal, starting October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Registration will remain open through October 31<sup>st</sup>. Registrations received after October 31<sup>st</sup> will be accepted <u>only</u> if space is available and a late fee of \$20.00 may be charged per participant.

**Visit our website at <u>www.hudsonrecreation.org</u> to register by logging in to your account.** If you, your child, or another family has <u>not</u> previously participated in Hudson Recreation programs, then a new account will need to be created in order to complete registration. ## **GRADES 2-8 PROGRAM DETAILS:**

### **Practices:**

Teams will practice 1x/week. Weekday practices could be held at any of the elementary schools or middle school, will last for 1 hour, and typically take place between 5:00pm-7:00pm. We make every effort to ensure that no practices take place after 8:00pm. Practice days and times will be determined once coaches are finalized. Practices will start as early as the week of November 13<sup>th</sup>.

#### Games:

Teams will play 1 game each week. Games will be held on Saturdays between 9:00am and 5:00pm, starting on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Exact games schedules for all divisions will be provided during the week Nov 27<sup>th</sup>. The last game/season end will be held on Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup>. No Games December 23<sup>rd</sup> and December 30<sup>th</sup>.

- Boys 2/3 & Girls 2/3 will play games at Forest Ave Elementary
- Boys 3/4 & Girls 3/4 will play games at Quinn Middle School
- Boys 5/6 and 7/8 & Girls 5/6 and 7/8 will play games at Farley School

#### Rosters:

Our hope is to finalize rosters by November 10<sup>th</sup> and have coaches reach out to their teams as soon as possible. Unless otherwise specifically requested otherwise during registration, siblings who play in the same division will be placed on the same team. Requests for specific coaches, teams, days/times for practice or to be paired with other children may not be honored, although you can include a note when registering your child. If your child has a conflict after he/she is placed onto a team and you decide to withdraw from the program we will provide you with a full refund. However, refund requests must be submitted to the Recreation Office by November 17<sup>th</sup> for consideration.

Note: Program dates, times, and locations are all subject to change at the discretion of Hudson Recreation.

# Kindergarten & Grade 1 Clinics - NEW in 2023 - Two 5-week Sessions

These clinics are for children currently in Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Participants will gather weekly to participate in a 50-minute clinic, for 5 weeks. Each week will consist of age appropriate drills and fun games, focused on learning and building on the fundamentals of basketball. Session 1 begins December 2<sup>nd</sup>. (No clinics on 12/23 or 12/30). Session 2 begins January 20<sup>th</sup>. Registration for Session 1 opens October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Registration for Session 2 will open December 4<sup>th</sup>. Registration fee: \$60.00.

#### Unified Basketball

Hudson Unified Basketball is a collaborative team sport, composed of athletes (students with developmental challenges) and partners. The program is designed to offer all children a skill-based, competitive team sport plus an interactive social learning experience. It is open to children/young adults. This program will start in late November each year. Registration will open October 23<sup>rd</sup>.
