- According to the United States Census Bureau, the town has a total area of 11.8 square miles.


ABOUT YOUR STATE...

Hudson Recreation has partnered once again with **Kids' Test Kitchen (KTK)** for upcoming 4-week and 6-week sessions, starting in January. Kids' Test Kitchen is on a mission to get young eaters cooking, tasting, and thinking about healthy ingredients! Continuing to *redefine kid food*; one lesson, and one child at a time!

Students will have undivided attention as they explore new or familiar foods in their raw, unmanipulated state. Then will work together, virtually, (via Zoom), to slice, dice, peel, measure, and cook until they have each prepared the finished dish. Participants learn about food safety, basic hygiene, and the responsibilities that come with working in the kitchen – like careful use of equipment and clean up!

Fresh-ka-bobs (4&6-week session) Simple Pineapple Curry (4&6-week session) Power Pancakes (4&6-week session) Atypical Tacos (4&6-week session) Veggie Spaghetti (6-week session) Green Smoothies (6-week session) (all items subject to change)

Recipes are easily modified to accommodate food allergies.

4-week session: January 6th, 13th, 20th, and 27th, 4:30pm-5:30pm

6-week sessions: (choose one):

Tuesdays - January 19th, 26th, February 2nd, 9th, 23rd, March 2nd; 4:00pm-5:00pm Wednesdays – January 27th, February 3rd, 10th, 24th, March 3rd, 10th; 5:00pm-6:00pm Thursdays – January 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th, February 4th, 11th; 5:00pm-6:00pm

Classes will take place virtually thru Kids' Test Kitchen's web portal. A link to the class will be provided after registration is completed. The link will include information on how to sign into the class and what ingredients will need to be purchased prior to the classes.

Lessons are suitable for students of nearly any age. Participants will actually be cooking, though, so younger students may need some help from a "sous chef" from time to time. In our experience, students 2nd grade and up have the attention and manual dexterity required to complete most lessons independently.

Cost:

\$56 for the 4-week session; \$84 for the 6-week session. Fee is per household.
