- Before its incorporation as a town in 1866, Hudson was a neighborhood and unincorporated village of Marlborough, and was known as “Feltonville”.
- Hudson’s population in 1866 was about 1800. In 2010, the population was 19,063.
- The first public library in Hudson opened in 1867 thanks to \$500 in financial assistance from Charles Hudson.
- According to the United States Census Bureau, the town has a total area of 11.8 square miles.

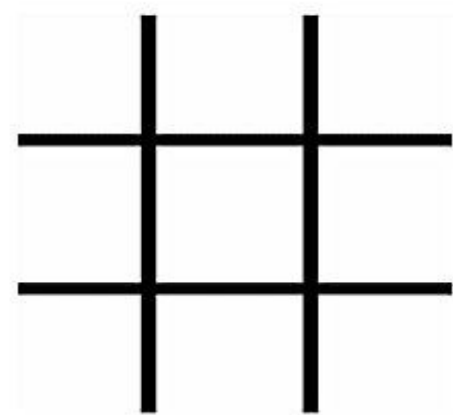
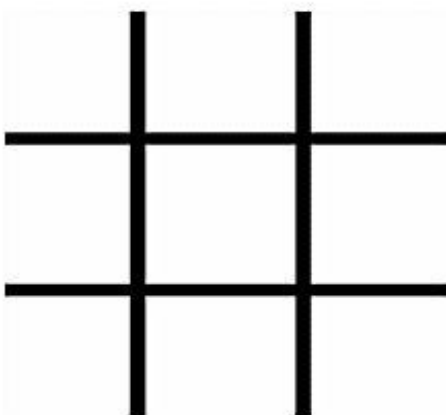
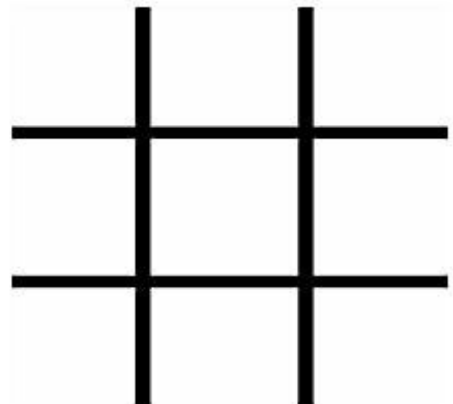
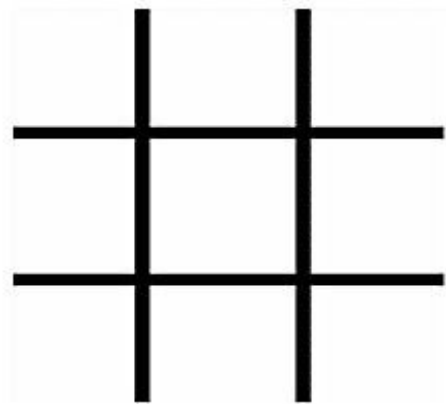
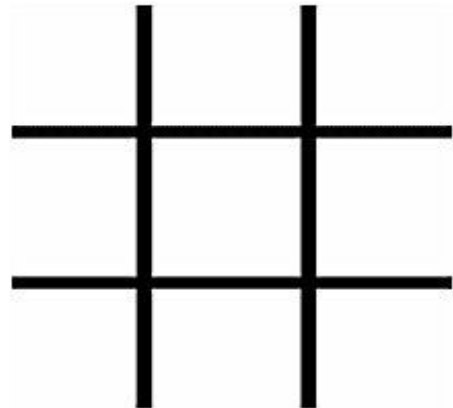
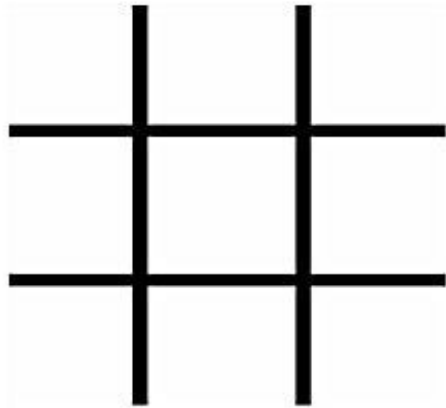
ABOUT YOUR STATE...

- The official state dessert of Massachusetts is Boston Cream Pie

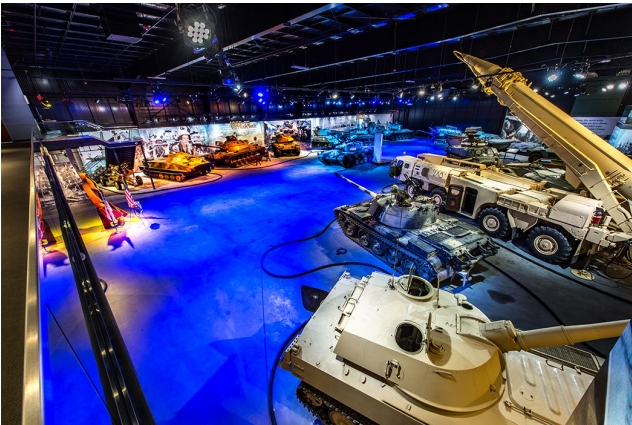
ABOUT STUFF IN GENERAL...

- ‘Dreamt’ is the only English word ending with ‘mt’.

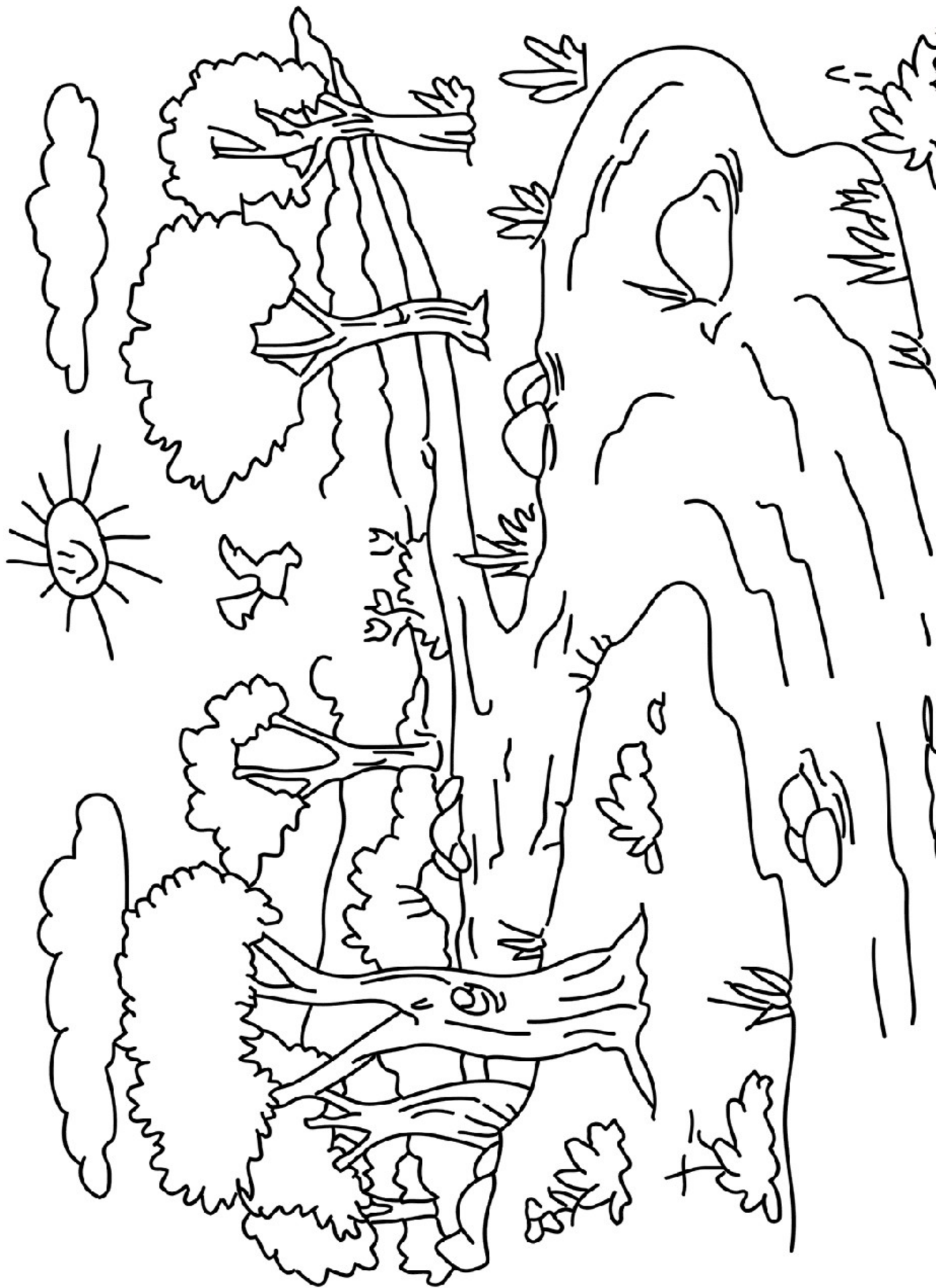

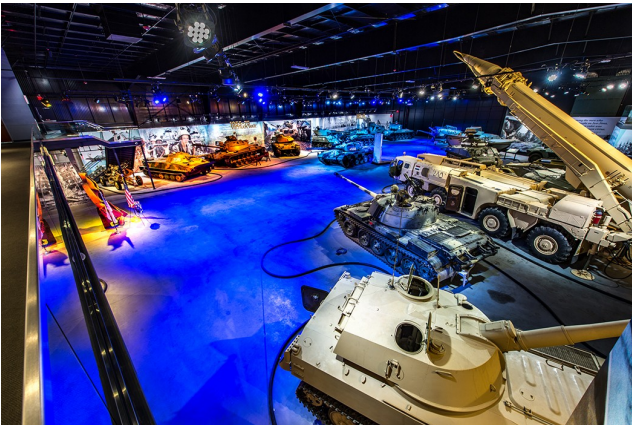
