Mini Golf-Design, Build, Play

In this exciting and hands-on program kids will dive into the fun world of mini golf! This unique program is designed to blend creativity, teamwork, and fundamental golf skills into an engaging experience. As the program progresses, we will work in teams to design and build new holes every week with fun themes to jump start children's creativity and imagination.

This is a 5-week program run by Skyhawks at Quinn Middle School on Wednesdays from Feb 26-Mar 26, 2025. Grades K-2 will run from 4pm-5pm and grades 3-6 will run from 5:15pm-6:15pm. Fees are **\$100pp**. Registration opens November 29th at 10am and will close on February 12th.

Nerf Wars

Individuals will sign up for **\$10pp** and will be organized into teams by Rec Staff on the day of the competition. Each team will be composed of an equal number of players. Nerf darts, pinnies and obstacles will be provided. Participants must supply their own Nerf blasters and must follow Hudson Recreation Guidelines and Rules that will be posted on our website prior to the event. Kids will get a minimum of 30mins of playing time and additional time for target practice. Eye protection will be provided by Hudson Recreation. Participants must be in grades 3–7 to play. Groups will be divided as follows: Grades 3–5 and Grades 5–7. Participants in grade 5 can sign up for either category. Registration opens December 2nd and will close on March 14th. Playing time will vary between 9am & 3pm based on grade level on March 29th @ Quinn Middle School.

Safe Sitter & Safe @ Home Courses

Safe Sitter w/ CPR (Babysitting class)- The program follows guidelines from the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Heart Association. **\$130pp** March 10th & 11th 5pm-7:30pm. Must be 10-16 years old to register.

Safe @ Home-Students learn how to practice safe habits, how to prevent unsafe situations, and what to do when faced with dangers such as power failures or weather emergencies. **\$55pp** March 24th 5pm-7pm. Must be 9-11 years old to register.

Classes will be held at Quinn Middle School. Registration opens December 2nd.
