



HUDSON RECREATION INNOVATION SESSION



A public forum was held on June 6, 2018. Approximately 45 people attended. The purpose of the forum was to provide residents with an opportunity to voice their opinions, describe their experiences and express their needs and desires regarding recreation in Hudson. The session began with a presentation summarizing:

- The current facilities and activities of Hudson Recreation
- Connections between health (individual and community) and recreation
- A summary of Survey Results

Participants were then asked to visit interactive Discussion Stations focused on:

Facilities: Existing and New

Programs: Existing and New

Events: Existing and New

Policies/Rules and Regulations

Participants were also asked to answer the following questions in writing:

- What does recreation mean to you?
- What do you consider to be the main benefit(s) of recreation?
- What is your favorite thing about Hudson Recreation?
- If you could do one thing to improve Hudson Recreation facilities, programs, events and/or policies what would it be?

Factors to consider

Participants were asked to consider the following factors when evaluating existing facilities and programs and/or thinking about potential future ones.

Capacity: Is there a need to increase capacity (administrative staff, seasonal volunteers, funding, etc.)? Who are potential partners (local, regional)?

Awareness: Is there a need to increase awareness of existing facilities and programs? More information? Information more broadly disseminated?

Education: Is there a need for public education regarding relationship between health and recreation and fitness?

Maintenance: Is there a need for more maintenance, upgrade and repairs of facilities?

Usage: Are there opportunities to increase usage by:

- Providing lighting for evening usage
- Increasing/improving parking availability
- Making walking/biking connections to increase access
- Increasing safety, ADA compliance
- Expanding days/hours of operation

Demographics: Is there a need to provide facilities/programs oriented to specific demographics?

- Pre-schoolers (ages 1-6)
- Adults (18-50)
- Seniors (55+)
- · Individuals with special needs

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE INNOVATION SESSION

The following represent the **priorities as identified by participants at the public forum**. They are listed in the order of the number of priority dots they received. The items listed first received 10 or more dots. The items listed after "Also" received between 5 and 9 dots.

The **number one** response regarding how to improve the playgrounds was to update and **improve the existing** ones or to **construct a new central playground.**

The **number one** response regarding how to improve the athletic fields was to provide **bathrooms** and **concessions**.

Fenced in parks especially at the Splash Pad and Wood Park

- More information regarding existing facilities (parks and playgrounds)
- Maintenance
- Covered/updated picnic area (especially at Wood Park)

The **number one** response regarding how to improve the parks was to **fence in** areas especially the **Splash Pad** and **Wood Park**.

- Maintenance (improve and more monitoring)
- Signage identifying trails and relevant information and map of all trails

- On-line information including maps
- Increase Safety- Set up a Community Board to form a hiking club so that people don't walk alone

TOWN BEACH

- Maintenance (more sand, fewer rocks, groom sand 2-3 times a season)
- Update/cleaner bathrooms
- Extend season

- Improve walking/biking connections

The **number one** responses regarding how to improve the town beach was to **better maintain the sandy area** (remove rocks, groom sand more frequently) with **cleaner bathrooms** coming in as a close second.



The **number one** response regarding desired **new events** is **family movies**.

The **top two** response regarding desired **policies are a fenced in dog park (**to deal with issues with dogs on Park Commission property) and a **Central Playground** (to deal with the issue of not being able to use school playgrounds during school hours).


