






















PROJECT GOALS




- Use public input to create the Dog Park design
- Create a safe and accessible, enclosed space for off-leash dogs and their owners
- Integrate the Dog Park into an existing Town recreation facility
- Design for minimal impact to natural resources
- Create accessible connections to & within the Dog Park
- Consider the dog parks connection to and impact on surrounding neighborhoods
- Design dog park to meet Stanton Foundation Guidelines



- 2015 HudDog (citizens group) is established
- 2018 Recreation Community Outreach Survey and Community Visioning Session
- 2019 Recreation Facilities Master Plan completed
- January 2020 Park Commission prioritized list of projects to be completed
- February 2020 COVID Pandemic
- March 2023: KZLA hired as consultant
- June 2023: Public Input Meeting
- Fall 2023: Continued site investigation

SITE 1: FARINA FIELD








Site Considerations:

- Existing open lawn
- Relatively flat
- Close proximity to Town center
- No parking lot or paved areas
- Possible connections to neighborhoods
- Close proximity to neighbor homes
- DPW property, approx 3/4 acre

- Existing driveway floods
- Wetlands surrounding site perimeter
- No existing electrical on site
- No current access to water on site



SITE 2: SAUTA FIELDS








Site Considerations:


- Partially wooded area
- Existing open level area along entrance drive
- Further away from Town Center
- Existing parking lot & paved area to site
- Less connected to neighborhoods
- Less impact on neighbor homes
- Park Commission Property, approx 1/2-3/4 acres

- Adjacent brook and wetlands
- Existing electrical on site
- Existing irrigation and access to water on site



PUBLIC MEETING RECAP







November 8,2023

129 online survey respondents:

Question 8 Do you prefer walking your dog on a leash, or visiting off-leash parks?:

- 39.18% (38/97) respondents answered I prefer walking "on-leash".
- 17.53% (17/97) prefer "off-leash".
- 38.14% (54/97) answered "both".

Question 9 Would you visit a new dog park in town?:

74.49% (73/98) respondents answered "yes".

Question 10 How important is it that the new dog park is walking distance from where you live?:

• 71.43% (70/98) of respondents answered "not at all important".

Question 14 What site is your preferred location for a new dog park?:

- 37 votes for Sauta and 34 for Farina.
- There were 10 votes for "neither"
- 8 suggestions for another site.




Since the survey:


- We have visited (2) potential sites for a dog park at Intel field
