

PROJECT GOALS



- Use public input to create the Dog Park design
- Create a safe and accessible, enclosed space for off-leash dogs and their owners
- Integrate the Dog Park into an existing Town recreation facility
- Design for minimal impact to natural resources
- Create accessible connections to & within the Dog Park
- Consider the dog parks connection to and impact on surrounding neighborhoods
- Design dog park to meet Stanton Foundation Guidelines

PROJECT HISTORY

- 2015 HudDog (citizens group) is established
- 2018 Recreation Community Outreach Survey and Community Visioning Session
- 2019 Recreation Facilities Master Plan completed
- January 2020 Park Commission prioritized list of projects to be completed
- February 2020 COVID Pandemic
- 2023: Dog Park planning now underway!

OUR DESIGN PROCESS

- Review revelant site material and documents
- Become familiar with both potential sites
- > Receive input from the community
 - Summarize input, and start concept designs
 - Present design concepts and preliminary cost estimates to Park Commission
 - Site selection (determined by the Park Commission)
 - Phase 2 Final Design Process, Construction Documents, and Cost Estimates





PROJECT SCOPE

A dog park at either site WILL have...*

- Fencing (5' min.)
- Potable water
- Shade for dogs & owners
- Dual gate entryway
- Accessible parking
- Dog waste bags/receptacles
- Seating
- Signage
- Surfacing

A dog park at either site MAY have...

Variables:

- Lighting
- Irrigation
- Agility play components
- Site selection might determine aesthetic:
 - Farina= Open Lawn
 - Sauta= Wooded

PROJECT SCOPE

We need input on..

- Proposed locations
- Types of surfacing (lawn, wood fiber, peastone, etc.)
- Types of play activities (natural, agility, water, etc.)
- Types of shade elements
- Added value elements (lighting, irrigation, etc.)







SITE 1: FARINA FIELD

May 16.2023

Site Considerations:

- Existing open lawn
- Relatively flat
- Close proximity to Town center
- No parking lot or paved areas
- Possible connections to neighborhoods
- Close proximity to neighbor homes
- DPW property, approx 3/4 acre

- Existing driveway floods
- Wetlands surrounding site perimeter
- No existing electrical on site
- No current access to water on site







SITE 2: SAUTA FIELDS

May 16,2023

Site Considerations:

- Partially wooded area
- Existing open level area along entrance drive
- Further away from Town Center
- Existing parking lot & paved area to site
- Less connected to neighborhoods
- Less impact on neighbor homes
- Park Commission Property, approx 1/2-3/4 acres

- Adjacent brook and wetlands
- Existing electrical on site
- Existing irrigation and access to water on site
